



The Leadership Project: Study and Practice

July 30 – August 17, 2017

This distinctive and multi-faceted academic summer program in Israel takes place at Oranim College in the beautiful Galilee. It offers students a unique opportunity to experience the real Israel, interact with Israelis from all walks of life, and receive an academic grounding in subjects connected to Israel's history and present.

Students will gain the knowledge necessary to effectively debunk mistruths being spread about Jews, Judaism and Israel. Numerous field study trips and excursions to different parts of the country will provide students with a first-rate tourist experience as well as a close-up look at some of the remarkable individuals and endeavors that are the secret of Israel's creativity, survival and resilience. Before returning home, students themselves will become adept at *krav maga* and emergency medical training.

The program welcomes undergraduates, graduate students as well as individuals who do not need academic credit for their participation.

Main program components

- Two academic courses (each one 38 hours, 3 American credits). Courses include lectures, workshops and field study
 1. Leadership: Theory and practice
 2. Israel: Successes, challenges and creative solutions
- *Krav Maga* – the globally acclaimed Israeli modern self-defense system
- Emergency Medical Training
- Touring significant sites around Israel
- Cultural events
- Language instruction
- Free time for independent travel
